- Famous story of woman caught in adultery (likely not in original manuscript) and Jesus' response

*Don't Be Conformed to this World

- Lack of Courage
 - Characterized by Fear / Passivity
- Lack of Control
 - Characterized by Anger / Pride

*But be transformed by the renewing of your mind
