Psalm 145:1-3

I will extol you, my God and King, and
bless your name *forever and ever*.

Every day I will bless you and praise
your name *forever and ever*. Great is
the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and
his greatness is *unsearchable*.

Psalm 145:4-5

One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts.

On the glorious splendor of your majesty, and on your wondrous works, I will meditate.
